The Women Empowerment Cell, CIT Gubbi Proudly organized a Session on "Women Hygienic Campaign"-A Sustainable Menstruation On 18<sup>th</sup> December 2017 at CIT campus.

To address this issue, **Green The Red**, a group of eco-activists and healthcare professionals, has launched a '**Cup and Cloth campaign**' supported by the **Karnataka State Pollution Control board (KSPCB).** The aim is to bring the government and the nation's attention to sustainable menstrual choices.
