Grievance Redressal mechanism for Faculty, staff and students

In order to maintain the transparency in taking the feedback on the faculty relevant to teaching learning process, online feedback collecting mechanism using Moodle software is in practice. Through which the students can give their genuine feedback on the faculty on various parameter related to the teaching-learning process. This unbiased feedback taking on faculty helps the Management/HoD's to monitor and prepare the corrective measures on the human resources.

Grievance Redressal mechanism for Faculty, staff and students in the institute has separate grievance redressal cell where Faculty and Students are the members of the grievance redressal cell. The committee comprises of Dean (Administration), Heads of Departments, coordinators and senior faculty members.

In addition, there are other committees like Anti-Ragging Committee, Hostel Committee, Women Grievance Redressal & Empowerment Cell, SC/ST and Minority Students Redressal Committee are functioning in the institution.

In line with the student's grievance redressal, the institution has nominated Chief Proctor who is the liaison member between the stake holders (parents and students) and HoD's/institution. The Chief Proctor ensures the conduction of proctor-students meetings conducted periodically. The report of the meetings to be concised and send to the concerned authorities for the necessary actions within the stipulated time. Women Grievance Redressal & Empowerment Cell monitors the grievances related to women faculty and girl students. The establishment of Anti Ragging Committee is followed according to the orders of the All-India Council of Technical Education, New Delhi.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC): It is a centralized body that looks into quality enhancement measures on the various activities handled by the institution. IQAC facilitates overall development of the students by creating student's centric learning environment by providing quality education.

Criteria for Fee waivers/scholarship

❖ CIT CAT

CIT-CAT admission test for the selection of deserved candidates for offering free engineering education. This test is open for the Students of Karnataka state who have completed their PUC with a minimum of 60% in PCM and who fall under Economically Weaker Section. The relaxation of 10% marks shall be considered for the students who are excelled in sports and physically challenged. The fact-finding committee visiting the houses of shortlisted candidates to cross check the economic status of the family. The final selection will be made considering the candidate's SSLC, PUC, CET ranking and CIT-CAT performance along with their communication skills and their economical background.

❖ SNQ

Fee waivers under SNQ as per Karnataka Examinations Authority Instructions and Guidelines, 5% of the seats in each college and in each course will be reserved as Supernumerary Quota (SNQ) in all Engineering Colleges. This quota is over and above the seat matrix issued by the Government. The tuition fee prescribed by the State Government for the particular college will be waived off. The candidate has to pay University / other fees only. This Supernumerary quota is not available for Architecture Course. All poor and meritorious candidates including General Merit are eligible for allotment of seats under Supernumerary quota (Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme) whose annual income of the family from all the sources is less than Rs.8.00 Lakhs.

Internal Continuous Evaluation System

Institution is affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University (VTU), and hence, it follows its rules and guidelines given by the university. Regarding the conduction of Internal assessment and evaluation process the internal assessment is carried out in a systematic manner for theory courses, laboratory courses, seminars and project. An academic calendar is prepared at the beginning of each semester and is made available on the college website and notice-boards of the departments.
