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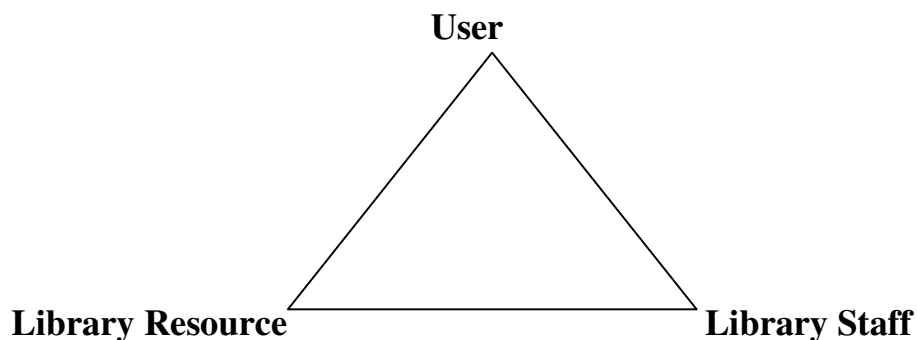

- ❖ To provide state-of-the-art library facilities.

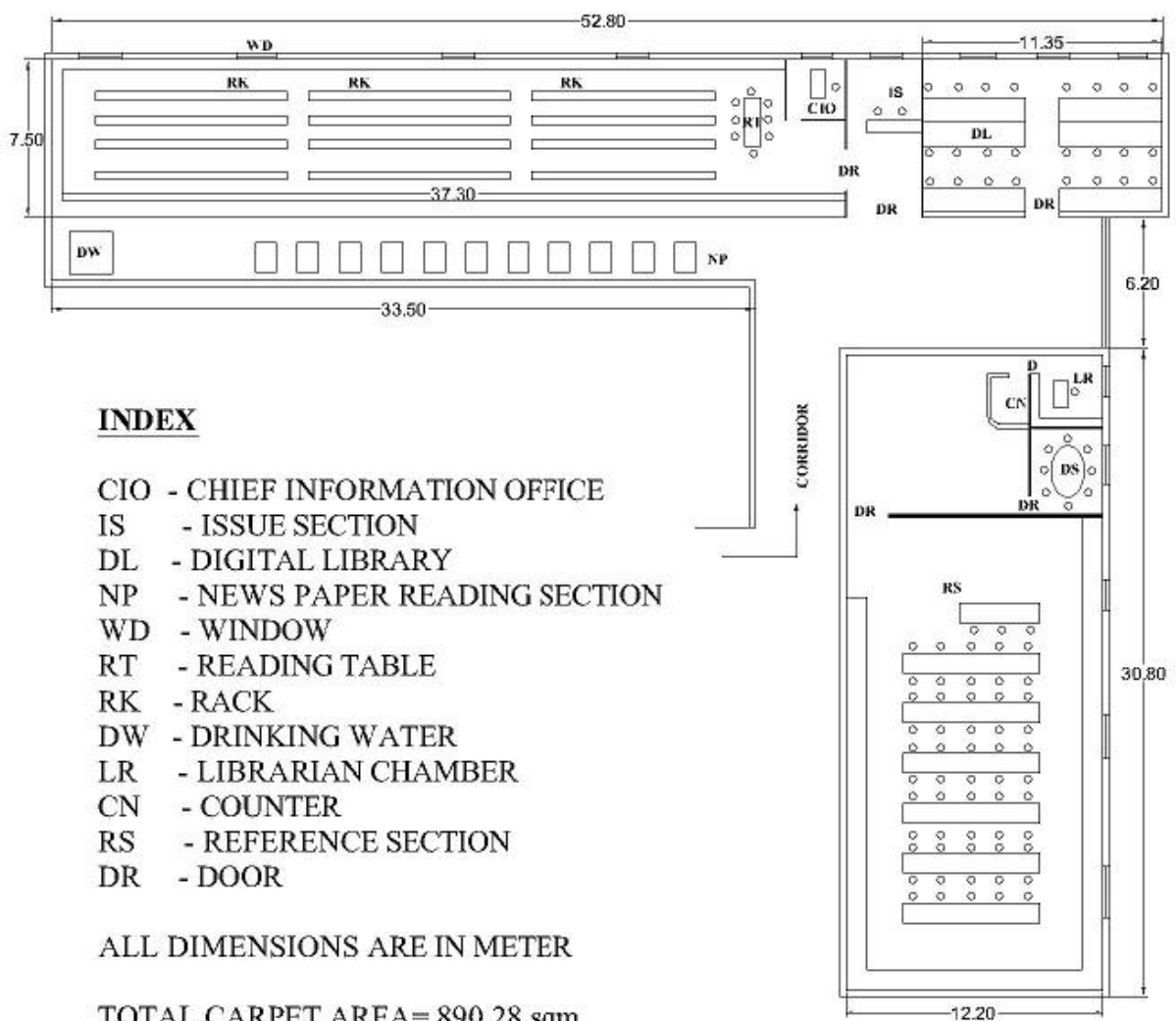
**Objective:**

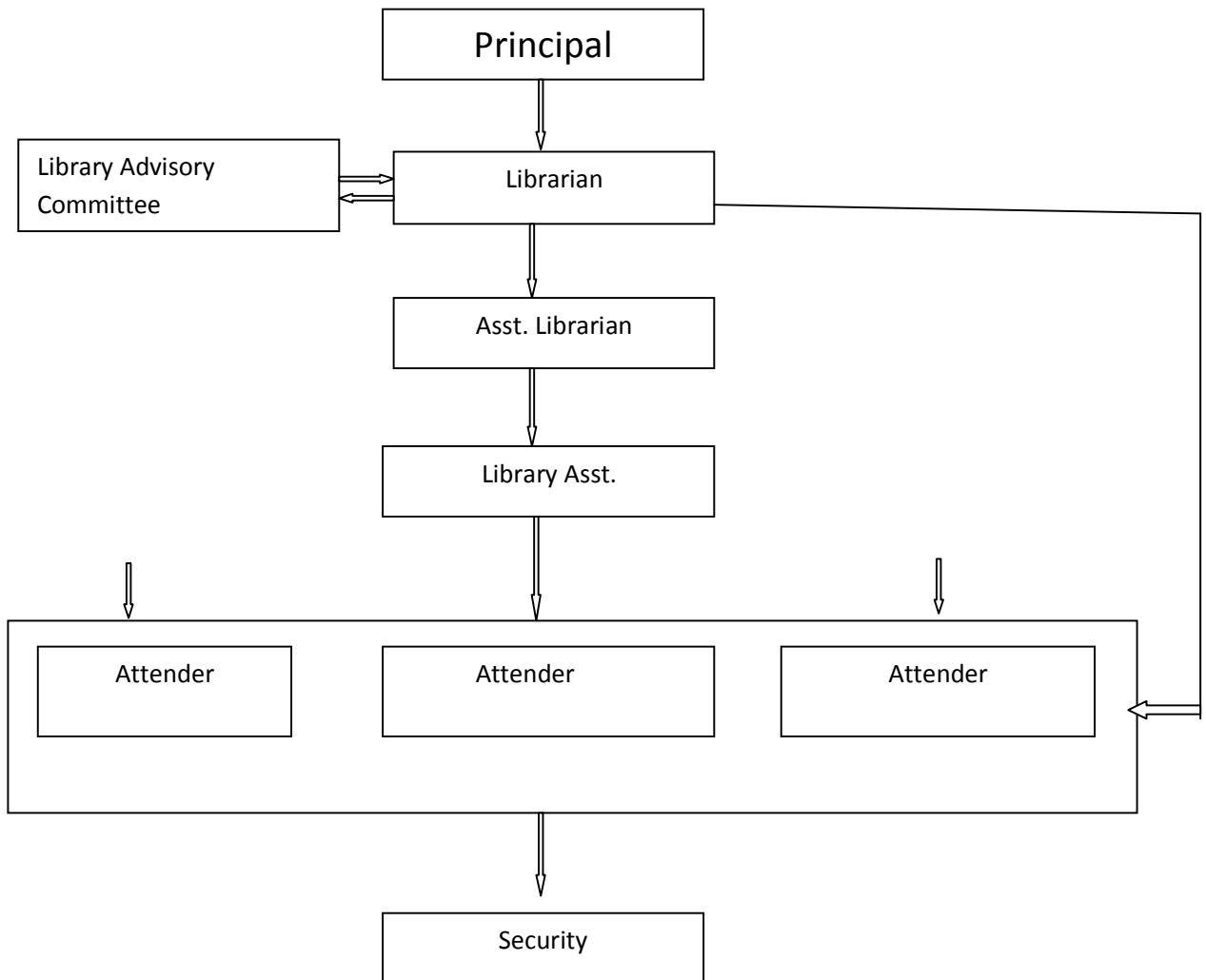

**Book-Bank facility:** The Library has Book Bank facility for all and SC/ST students. The Books from the Book Bank are issued for the whole semester and every semester..

**Reprographic services:** Photocopying/Xerox facility (both color and B&W) is available for the users of the Library with reasonable charges.

**On-line public access catalogues:** The Online Public Access catalog allows for the access of bibliographic databases of the books, Reports, CD-ROMs and journals available in the central library.

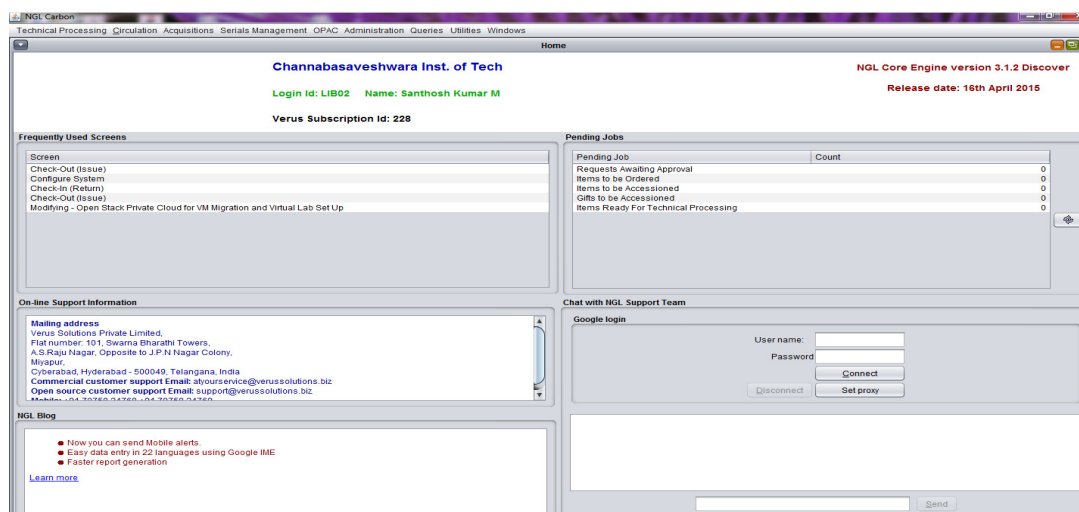

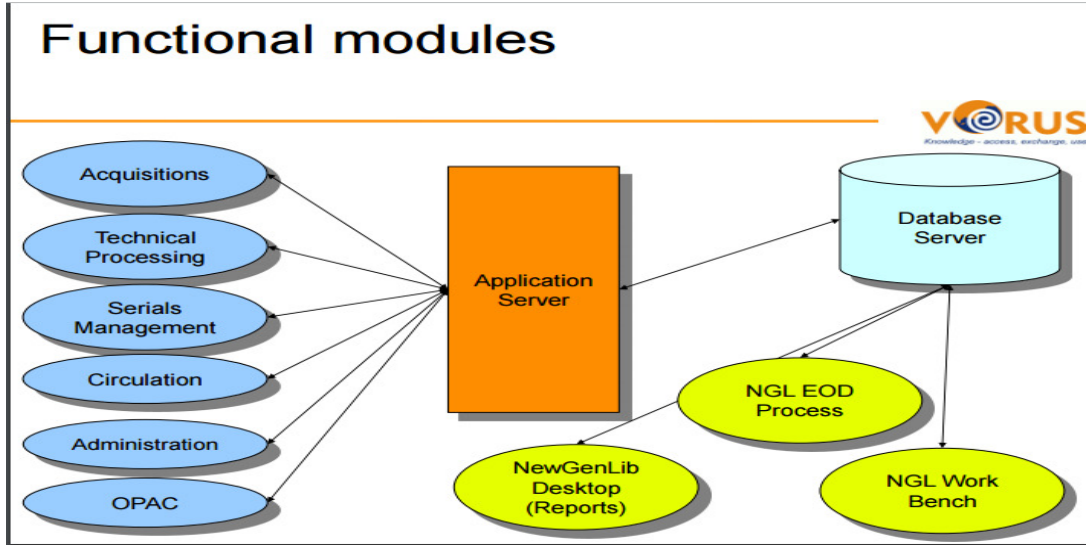

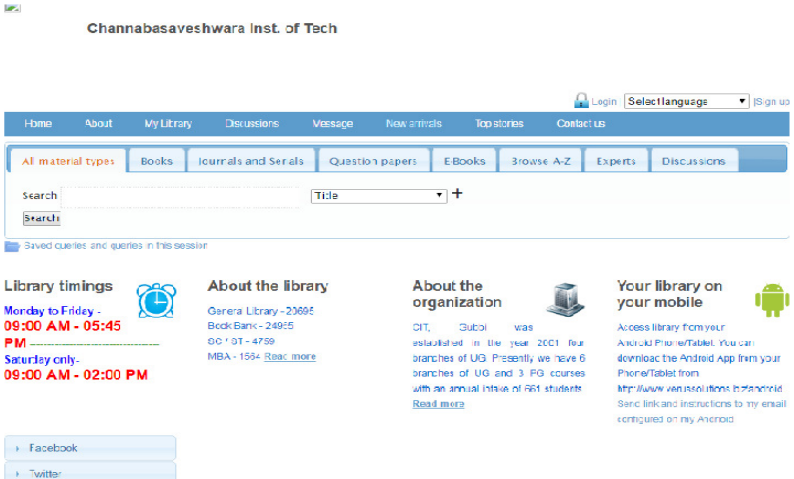
